



PRIVACY POLICY

The Foodservice Wellness Institute™ respects your privacy. We do not collect personally identifiable information about you unless you voluntarily provide it, such as when you send feedback to The Foodservice Wellness Institute, register for one of The Foodservice Wellness Institute's courses or respond to a survey. If you voluntarily provide your email address or other contact information, we might also use it to inform you of changes to The Foodservice Wellness Institute, to survey you about your use or opinion of The Foodservice Wellness Institute, or to ask for your support. At your request, we will remove your contact information from our files.

We do not make your contact information or any other personally identifiable information available to anyone outside The Foodservice Wellness Institute or its service providers (who use the information only for authorized Foodservice Wellness Institute purposes) unless we are legally required to do so.

In addition to the above, we collect certain anonymous (non-personally identifiable) information to help us improve The Foodservice Wellness Institute web site and to evaluate the access and use of The Foodservice Wellness Institute materials and the impact of The Foodservice Wellness Institute on the worldwide educational community:

We collect information you provide about your use of and satisfaction with The Foodservice Wellness Institute through email you send us, through The Foodservice Wellness Institute feedback form, and through The Foodservice Wellness Institute surveys, whether or not you voluntarily include your contact information.

We may use web analysis tools that are built into The Foodservice Wellness Institute web site to measure and collect anonymous session information.

We also use "cookies" to improve your Foodservice Wellness Institute web experience and to collect anonymous information about how you use The Foodservice Wellness Institute. However, cookies are not required for The Foodservice Wellness Institute use. If your browser is configured not to accept cookies, you will still be able to access The Foodservice Wellness Institute and its content.

When we report information about The Foodservice Wellness Institute access, use, and impact, we report aggregate, non-personally identifiable data. Occasionally, we report quoted feedback from users. We do not attribute feedback to specific individuals unless we obtain permission to use that person's name along with the feedback.
